# UEA 2021 LEGISLATIVE VOTING RECORD SUMMARY

## SENATE VOTE BILLS

### **HB 182 S2 (Craig Hall)**

*UEA's Position: Support*

Clarifies existing statute to identify the appropriate court for an educator who appeals a termination. UEA brought this issue to the legislature.

### EDUCATOR HEARINGS AMENDMENTS

*Passed in the Senate and in the House.*

### **SB 107 S7 (Todd Weiler)**

*UEA's Position: Oppose*

Implements thresholds and requirements for the test-to-stay testing program that go into effect if two percent of the school population tests positive for Covid-19. Also requires all school districts to offer in-person learning a minimum four days a week as an option for students.

### IN-PERSON INSTRUCTION PRIORITIZATION

*Passed in the Senate and in the House.*

### **SB 115 S1 (Lincoln Fillmore)**

*UEA's Position: Oppose*

Requires private employers that participate in the Utah Retirement System to disclose employee compensation information through the Utah Public Finance Website or the employer's own website, if the employer is not currently required to disclose the information.

### RETIREMENT SYSTEM TRANSPARENCY REQUIREMENTS

*Passed in the Senate and in the House.*

### **SB 142 S1 (Lincoln Fillmore)**

*UEA's Position: Support*

Changes the Enhancement for At-Risk Students line item to WPU based funding. Also requires the Public Education Appropriations Subcommittee to evaluate and make recommendations for future legislation regarding public education funding.

### PUBLIC EDUCATION FUNDING AMENDMENTS

*Passed in the Senate and in the House.*

### **SB 178 (Lincoln Fillmore)**

*UEA's Position: Support*

Extends or provides flexibility regarding certain education deadlines and spending restrictions.

### EDUCATION DEADLINE AND FISCAL FLEXIBILITY

*Passed in the Senate and in the House.*

### **SB 184 S3 (Kathleen Riebe)**

*UEA's Position: Support*

Removes accountability requirements based on statewide tests for 2020-2021 because statewide standardized tests were not given in Spring 2020.

### SCHOOL ASSESSMENT AND ACCOUNTABILITY AMENDMENTS

*Passed in the Senate and in the House.*

### **SB 187 S3 (Ron Winterton)**

*UEA's Position: Oppose*

Originally eliminated enforcement of wearing masks on school grounds, later changed to require health departments to consult with school districts on public health orders that directly affect local education agencies and private schools.

### LOCAL EDUCATION AGENCY POLICIES AMENDMENTS

*Passed in the Senate and in the House.*

### **SB 242 (John Johnson)**

*UEA's Position: Oppose*

Enacts a tax credit (voucher) for expenses resulting from disenrollment in public education and enrollment in private education or home school.

### ALTERNATIVE EDUCATION TAX CREDIT AMENDMENTS

*Failed in the Senate.*
